
Urban Garden Planting Calendar


NYC Metropolitan Area

The information was obtained over a 15 year period from experiences of gardeners living throughout the five boroughs.

Special Consideration Crops

Asparagus i Best pianted as crowns in a perennial garden, mid-April to end of May

Chives i Best planted as seeds or transplants in a perennial garden, mid-April to end of May

Gartic | Best planted as cloves in September or October

Horseradish : Best planted as root cuttings in a perennial garden, mid-April through end of May

Jerusalem Artichoke | Best planted as tubers, mid-May through early June

Perennial Herbs: Best planted as transplants in a perennial garden, mid-May through early June

Rhubarb | Best planted as crowns in a perennial garden, mid-April through end of May

Strawberry | Best planted as plants in a perennial garden throughout May
